




Radiologists in this academic group are doing well – most cancer detection rates fall in the expected range. One rad needs help – can you spot which one?




Radiologists 1-4 are top performers, achieving CDRs almost perfectly aligned with PI-RADS expectations:



Radiologists 5-9 are more scattered but still risk-stratify patients well:



Radiologist 10 is an outlier, achieving a *negative* association with CDR at PI-RADS 3-5:
